How To Do The GPS Experiment

Set the alarms on your phone or watch to go off 3-5 times during the day. When they go off, go through the GPS questions:

God Focus: Imagine God is saying to you, "What do you need from me?" Then tell Him what you need! Your needs are an opportunity for God to show you His love. "God, I'm depending on you. Here's what I need from you right now...courage to invite someone to church or Self-control to do what's right or peace because a situation is tense or wisdom to make the best decision..."

Purpose: "God, I want your will to be done here on earth as it is heaven. I'm here to do your will, not mine."

Serve: "What do you want me to say or do right now for you? Is there someone you want me to serve in your name?"
