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A holy discontent is something that creates a “righteous anger” in you. It’s a burning inside that spurs us to action. It could be any issue: homelessness, starvation, education, injustice, sex-slave industry, etc.

Clue #1: Your holy discontent most likely will come from the place where you hurt the most or where you were hurt the most.

Clue #2: Your hold discontent will have nothing to do with you. It will have everything to do with serving others.

Clue #3: It only takes what you already have to make a difference.

Helping people discover and use their spiritual gifts  
Caring for the sick and dying  
Caring for the elderly  
Spousal abuse or child abuse  
Child trafficking  
Homelessness  
Bullying
