**Conversational prayer** 

When you wake up, start a conversation with Him that you carry on all day (don't stop talking to Him). Tell Him...

- How you feel
- What you are concerned about
  - What you are grateful for
  - What's frustrating you
  - Where you are in pain

## **Ask Him questions**

- Is there something you want me to do about this situation?
  - Is there anything you want to say to me?
  - How can I build this friendship with you?
  - Do you want me to serve anyone today?
  - Am I "off the path" in any area of my life?

#### Ask for His help

- Give me wisdom with this situation
- Please show me how to handle this better
  - Please help with this need in my life

# Remember why you are doing it: Only about His friendship

## **How Can I Know God Is Speaking?**

- Does it fit the character of God?
- What does the Bible say about this?
- Is it wise?
- Does it fit who God made me to be?
- What do wise people say about this?
- When in doubt, ask again

"If you believe God has told you to do something, ask him to confirm it to you three times: through his Word, through circumstances, and through other people who may know nothing of the situation."
