Sample Prayer When You Need God's Guidance

<u>Tell Him You need Him</u>: *Jesus, I need your help. I have this decision to make and I have no idea what the right one is...*

Ask God for guidance: So I'm turning to you for guidance.

<u>Claim His promise:</u> You PROMISED in Psalm 32:8 that you WILL instruct me, teach me, and counsel me. So thank you that you are already starting to guide me as I listen to you.

<u>Neutralize your will:</u> I'm not telling you what to do. I'm asking you. It is not <u>my will be done</u>. It's <u>your will be done</u>. Show me what you want and I will do it.

<u>Thank Him while you wait for Him to guide</u>: While I wait, thank you that I know you are already working. I can't wait to see what you do.

Resign as master of the board (Like a board game)
