4 Levels: of listening to God

Level 1 - Blind faith: We believe God is with us but are never aware of His presence and see no activity of God

Level 2 - Sensing God's presence: Occasionally aware of His presence

Level 3 - Seeing God at work: You see God at work in your life

Level 4 - Conversational relationship: Friendship with a personal God who communicates

3 Common Attitudes Towards God's Will

Level 1 (Ignoring God's Will): These people largely disregard the concept of actively seeking or following God's will.

Level 2 (Selective or Partial Seeking): People in this group tend to think about God's will only when facing major life choices like marriage, careers, or where to live. They might use general Bible rules for guidance, or follow their gut feelings, assuming if something feels right, it's from God. They also tend to keep their faith separate from other parts of their lives, like work or hobbies, so they only think about God's will in church or during prayer time, not in everyday situations.

Level 3 (Actively Seeking and Submitting): These individuals believe God has a detailed plan for their lives and actively seek His guidance through prayer, Bible study, the Holy Spirit, wise counsel, circumstances, and their God-given gifts. They prioritize obedience and focus on God's glory as the ultimate purpose.
